



CHILD AND VULNERABLE ADULTS PROTECTION FROM DRUG ABUSE

St James Parochial Church Council has adopted the Diocesan Policy on the protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults from drug abuse. A copy of this policy is available for inspection. As far as this affects St James Church, it should be noted that illegal drugs, harmful substances are prohibited in any event or activity. Alcohol may not be brought or served onto the premises.

The only exception being alcohol either used in worship or ancillary to an act of worship or an event carried out by St James Church.

Smoking is not permitted anywhere on the premises, this includes the outdoor areas around the church.

For the purpose of this policy, the expression "church premises" means our church, the church hall and stage, the chapel and all other rooms and corridors, our car park and surrounding grounds.
